
A bold and energetic red blend, TD-9 2018 offers a vibrant fusion of fruit intensity, floral charm, and plush tannins, rooted in the spirit of adventure.

Region and Vineyards



Shafer farms all these sites using sustainable viticulture. These vineyard blocks are chosen not only for their quality but for their complementary nature in a blend. Long hang times in 2018 allowed fruit to ripen slowly and develop **complex aromas, ripe tannins, and vivid flavors**—ideal conditions for crafting a red blend of richness and energy.



The 2018 vintage was marked by a cool and consistent summer, producing grapes with excellent color, bright aromatics, and refined acidity. Harvested between **23.5° and 25.5° Brix**, the fruit entered the cellar in pristine condition.

The blend is composed of **56% Merlot**, **23% Cabernet Sauvignon**, and **21% Malbec**, aged for **20 months in 100% new French oak barrels** (Allier and Tronçais). This élevage adds polish, complexity, and supple texture to the naturally vibrant blend. With **15.3% alcohol**, TD-9 2018 is rich and generous, yet finely balanced by juicy freshness and well-knit structure.

Tasting Notes

- Color: Deep ruby with violet highlights.
- **Aroma:** Intense and aromatic, featuring summer berries, rose petal, rhubarb, raspberry, and black cherry jam. Floral and earthy tones add lift and intrigue.
- **Palate:** Lush and energetic, brimming with red and black berry fruit, spice, and a hint of wild herbs. Plush tannins and a savory finish deliver length and elegance.

Composition: 56% Merlot, 23% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Malbec

Did you know?

TD-9 is named after the **International Harvester TD-9 tractor** that John Shafer taught himself to operate when he left his corporate life in Chicago to start Shafer Vineyards in 1973—a symbol of risk, reinvention, and the adventurous Napa spirit.

Wine Pairing Ideas

- **Grilled duck breast with cherry glaze:** The wine's fruit core and supple texture echo the richness and sweetness of the dish.
- **Beef tenderloin with rosemary jus:** A classic pairing that highlights the wine's structure and savory notes.
- **Mushroom and thyme risotto:** Earthy flavors enhance the wine's herbal and spicy complexity.
- **Aged Manchego or Tomme de Savoie:** Nutty, semi-hard cheeses soften the blend's youthful tannins and frame its red fruit.



James Suckling (JS): 93 Points (2018)

This has a meaty nose with grilled plums, smoke, tapenade and dried leaves. Some tomato paste. It's medium-to full-bodied with firm, chewy tannins. Broad and flavorful with a distinctively savory, saline finish. 56% merlot, 23% cabernet sauvignon and 21% malbec. Better from 2021.



Jeb Dunnuck (JD): 93 Points (2018)

The 2018 TD-9 Proprietary Red Blend is based on 56% Merlot, 23% Cabernet Sauvignon, and the rest Malbec. It's another balanced, charming, and impeccably made wine from this estate that has lively red and blue fruits, scorched earth, graphite, and licorice aromas and flavors as well as a medium to full-bodied, elegant style on the palate. It shows the more streamlined, focused style of the 2018 vintage and is going to evolve for 10-12 years.



Vinous (Antonio Galloni) (VN): 92 Points (2018)

The 2018 TD-9, Shafer's Merlot-based blend, is just as delicious from bottle as it was from barrel. Succulent dark red cherry/red plum fruit, licorice, spice, lavender and dried herbs are front and center. Readers will find a gorgeous 2018 that is ready to deliver plenty of pleasure from the get-go. (AG) (1/2021)
