

Region and Vineyards



The vineyards are cultivated without irrigation, resulting in smaller, highly concentrated grapes. This dry farming approach forces the roots to delve deeply into the soil, contributing to the wine's structure, minerality, and unique Napa expression.


Winemaking

The **2019 Cabernet Sauvignon** is crafted from **100% Cabernet Sauvignon**, picked at peak ripeness during the warm September and October months to ensure rich fruit character. After harvest, the wine undergoes **12 months of aging in French oak barrels**, which imparts complex notes of vanilla and spice while softening the wine's tannins. The grapes are vinified to create a plush, full-bodied style, with each step carefully tailored to produce a wine that embodies Caymus' signature approach.

With **14.6% alcohol**, this Cabernet Sauvignon showcases Napa Valley's warmth, leading to a rich, supple palate that is approachable yet age-worthy.

Tasting Notes

- Color: Deep garnet with a slight red-fawn edge.
- Aroma: Expressive nose of French oak, cassis, saddle leather, and espresso.
- **Palate**: Full-bodied and layered, featuring abundant tannins and notes of ripe dark fruit, hints of rustic oatmeal, and a long, satisfying finish.

Wine Pairing Ideas

- **Braised Short Ribs with Root Vegetables**: The rich, savory meat complements the wine's dark fruit and supple tannins, while root vegetables enhance its earthy undertones.
- **Duck Confit with Black Cherry Reduction**: The wine's bold structure and subtle notes of cassis pair beautifully with the duck's richness and the cherry sauce's sweetness.
- **Grilled Portobello Mushrooms with Thyme**: The earthy flavors and herbaceous notes harmonize with the wine's oaky, complex finish.
- **Aged Gouda or Parmigiano-Reggiano**: The nutty, intense flavors of aged cheese balance the wine's tannins, accentuating its depth and complexity.



Wine Spectator (WS): 92 Points (2019)

A rich, showy style, with a very creamy texture to its mix of warmed vanilla, plum and boysenberry puree, and melted black licorice flavors. A mocha notes swirls around the fruit on the finish. Drink now through 2028.



Wine Spectator (WS): 92 Points (2018)

Very lush and caressing in feel, with a flashy display of creamed plum, boysenberry and açaí berry fruit liberally laced with milk chocolate and melted black licorice notes. Drink now through 2028.
