Birichino Rodnick Farm Pinot Noir 2021 is an extraordinary expression of the Chalone AVA, showcasing the unique character of granite- and limestone-rich soils combined with high-altitude elegance.

### Region and Vineyards

The **Rodnick Farm** vineyard is situated in the **Chalone AVA**, nestled in the **Gabilan Range** near **Pinnacles National Park**. This unique site lies on the eastern side of the **Salinas Valley**, an area defined by its weathered granite debris and calcareous soils—ancient marine deposits uplifted by tectonic forces.

The vineyard was originally planted by **Dick Graff** in **1986**, featuring older clones such as **Swan and Chalone 46**, as well as newer blocks of **Pommard and 114 clones**. The vineyard's volcanic soils and high altitude impart a distinctive **mineral-driven character**, often blurring the line between varietal identification. The organic farming practices, including regenerative methods with **heritage sheep** and composting, enhance the vineyard's biodiversity and the wine's natural purity.

### Winemaking

The **2021 vintage** was harvested on **September 3**, under ideal conditions. Fermentation was conducted **spontaneously** using native yeasts, ensuring a pure expression of terroir.

The wine was bottled **unfiltered**, preserving its vibrant energy and complex aromatics. The alcohol level of **13%** highlights the balanced ripeness achieved in this cool-climate vineyard, while the acidity (**5.7 g/L**) and pH (**3.58**) reflect its refreshing structure and precision. The final production was limited to only **165 cases**, emphasizing the artisanal approach taken by Birichino.

### **Tasting Notes**

- Color: Bright ruby red with translucent clarity.
- Aroma: A captivating bouquet of tart cherries, roasted herbs, and a subtle meaty undertone, underscored by delicate notes of dried flowers and a hint of minerality.
- Palate: Light to medium-bodied, featuring flavors of cranberries, red currants, and a touch of smokiness. The wine's silky tannins and vibrant acidity create a precise, balanced structure, leading to a long, mineral-driven finish.

Composition: 100% Pinot Noir





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#### Did You Know?

The **Rodnick Farm vineyard** is home to heritage breeds of **sheep and herding dogs**, which contribute to its regenerative farming practices. This organic, biodiverse approach enhances the vineyard's soil health and supports the production of wines with exceptional purity and terroir expression.

#### Wine Pairing Ideas

- **Wild mushroom tart**: The wine's earthy complexity complements the umamirich flavors of mushrooms.
- **Herb-crusted pork tenderloin**: The tart cherry and savory notes of the wine balance the richness of the pork and herbs.
- **Grilled salmon with a soy glaze**: The wine's vibrant acidity and subtle smokiness pair beautifully with the richness of the fish and the umami glaze.
- **Duck confit with roasted vegetables**: The wine's silky texture and bright fruit enhance the dish's savory and caramelized elements.



Robert Parker (RP): 93 Points (2021)

The 2021 Pinot Noir Rodnick Farm informs the taster of its rocky, mountainous high desert origins, with a sweeping, intensely focused nose of chaparral, quarry dust and crushed red fruits, flanked by a balancing sweet tobacco richness. The palate is plush yet pliable, lined with a rocky tension that comes to the fore in the taut, inward and blazingly mineral finish—a beautiful expression of this unique California terroir that will easily reward time in the cellar.
