## Kadette Pinotage 2021

Stellenbosch, South Africa

### Region and Vineyards

The **Kadette Pinotage** is sourced from vineyards in **Stellenbosch**, a renowned South African wine region known for its optimal growing conditions for Pinotage. Stellenbosch enjoys a Mediterranean climate moderated by the Atlantic Ocean, which brings freshness and balance to the wines.

The vines used for this wine range between **7 and 22 years** of age and are planted on **decomposed granite** and **Hutton** soils, which provide excellent drainage. With **supplemental irrigation**, these vines produce **6 to 7 tons per hectare**, a controlled yield that ensures concentrated flavors in the grapes.

### Winemaking

The vintage saw a late harvest due to cooler growing conditions, which contributed to producing elegant wines with **softer tannin structures**, making them accessible at an earlier stage.

Fermentation took place in **open-top concrete fermenters** at **28°C**. The skins were mechanically punched down every two hours to maximize the extraction of flavors and tannins. The juice was drawn off the skins after **three days**, followed by malolactic fermentation. The wine was then matured for **12 months** in **second- and third-fill French oak barrels** from Nevers.

### Tasting Notes

- **Color:** Deep, intense plum.
- **Aroma:** Attractive scents of **red currant**, **black cherry**, and **strawberry jam**, with a hint of **nutmeg** and **wood spice**.
- **Palate:** The palate is medium to full-bodied, with finely textured tannins and flavors of **red candy**, **bright cherries**, and a touch of **nutmeg** oak spice and **dark chocolate**. The acidity is well-balanced with the fruit and wood components, adding freshness to the red and black fruit flavors on the finish.



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## Did You Know?

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**Pinotage**, South Africa's signature grape, is a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault. This unique combination produces wines that are both fruity and powerful, often characterized by red and black berry aromas, with smoky and spicy notes.

## Wine Pairing Ideas

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- **Pizza:** The fruity and spicy flavors of Pinotage perfectly complement the rich, grilled toppings of a pizza.
- **Pasta:** The wine's supple tannins pair beautifully with pasta dishes featuring tomato or meat-based sauces.
- **Barbequed Meat:** The spicy notes and ripe fruit of the Pinotage enhance the smoky flavors of barbequed meats.
- **Venison Stew:** The depth and tannic structure of this wine balance the richness of a venison stew or game ragout.

### James Suckling (JS) : 93 Points (2021)

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*Plums, currants, wet stones and violets on the nose. Medium body with finely grained tannins. Delicious core of berries and a velvety texture. Elegant and refined with a subtle touch of succulent sour cherries lifting the finish. Drink or hold.*

### Robert Parker (RP) : 89 Points (2021)

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*Subtly spiced and with aromas of succulent red fruit skin, the 2021 Kadette Pinotage offers delightful potpourri aromas. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is fresh with a balanced structure. It ends with a food-friendly finish and lingering tannic edge. Enjoy with food. After resting a year in used French oak barrels, just over one-third of a million bottles were produced.*

### Wine Enthusiast (WE) : 90 Points (2020)

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*Light notes of eucalyptus and oak spice mingle on the nose and reappear on the fresh palate. Nicely balanced by good acidity and concentrated fruit flavors, this Pinotage is smooth and finishes with notes of tobacco.*
