
Bogle Vineyards Petite Sirah 2021 is a bold and expressive red wine, honoring over 50 years of farming tradition and deeply rooted in Clarksburg's viticultural history.

### Region and Vineyards



Petite Sirah has been at the heart of **Bogle Vineyards** since **1968**, when the family first planted this grape on their Clarksburg estate. Known as the "heritage varietal" of Bogle, Petite Sirah thrives in the region's rich, alluvial soils, which promote excellent drainage and concentration in the fruit. The old vines, with their low yields, produce berries that are intensely flavored and deeply pigmented, ideal for crafting wines of **great color**, **structure**, and **complexity**.



The **2021 Bogle Petite Sirah** is carefully vinified to preserve its bold, varietal character while ensuring balance and approachability. After hand-harvesting the grapes at optimal ripeness, fermentation takes place under **temperature control**, allowing for a gentle extraction of color and tannins.

The wine is then aged for **12 months in American oak barrels**, a deliberate choice that imparts layers of **vanilla**, **black pepper**, and subtle **spices** to complement the natural fruit intensity of Petite Sirah. This extended barrel aging also helps soften the wine's robust tannins, resulting in a smooth, velvety texture that makes it enjoyable both in its youth and with further aging.

### **Tasting Notes**

- **Color**: Inky purple with deep ruby highlights, showcasing its concentration.
- **Aroma**: Inviting notes of **blue fruits**, including ripe boysenberry and blueberry, leap from the glass, accompanied by hints of **spice** and **black pepper**.
- Palate: Rich and full-bodied, with layers of blackberry, plum, and subtle notes
  of toasted oak. The wine is well-structured, with soft yet firm tannins, lingering
  spice, and a long, textured finish.

#### Did You Know?

Petite Sirah was the first red grape planted by the **Bogle family** in 1968, marking the beginning of their journey in California's Clarksburg region. Often referred to as "Durif" in France, Petite Sirah is celebrated for its ability to produce wines of deep color, bold tannins, and exceptional aging potential.

### Wine Pairing Ideas

- **Smoked lamb shoulder with rosemary**: The wine's bold tannins and ripe fruit flavors balance the rich, smoky character of the lamb.
- **Braised short ribs with blackberry barbecue sauce**: The dark fruit notes in the wine enhance the sweet and savory flavors of the ribs.
- **Grilled portobello mushrooms with balsamic glaze**: The earthiness of the mushrooms pairs beautifully with the wine's structure and spice.
- **Smoked gouda cheese**: The creamy, smoky flavors of the cheese harmonize with the wine's richness and oak influence.



### Wine Enthusiast (WE): 91 Points (2018)

Delicious blackberry, blueberry and dark-chocolate flavors are wrapped in thick but soft tannins. This is a full-bodied wine, with a mouthcoating texture. Best Buy.



#### Wine Spectator (WS): 89 Points (2016)

A perky, zesty red, with user-friendly blackberry and spicy incense notes that finish with lively tannins. Drink now through 2023.
