Niederberg Helden Riesling Auslese 2021

Mosel, Germany

Ripe and a hint of the exotic but not too much, still very clear and pure, yet boasting aromatic, lively flavours of nectarine, yellow plum and fresh apricot with underlying savoury slate and earthy nuances.

Helden has heavier soils and a little less slate content than those of the Juffer and Juffer Sonnenuhr, typically producing wines that are **more powerful, richer and earthier**.

Thomas Haag of Schloss rates the 2011s highly: "They should age very well, a little different to classic vintages because of slightly lower acidity, they are similar to 2007 but purer. It is such an elegant vintage because of the lack of botrytis."

Composition: 100% Riesling



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Robert Parker (RP) : 94 Points (2021)

The 2021 Niederberg Helden Auslese is based on healthy fruit with just a tiny bit of botrytis berries. The nose is clear and very delicate but also intense. Light and very delicate on the palate, with fascinating purity and salinity, this is a weightless Auslese with stimulating lemon bitters on the finish. It's highly digestible if you don't fear high acidity levels. 7% stated alcohol. Natural cork. Tasted at the domaine in July 2022.



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
