The **growing season** saw a dry, cool autumn followed by generous winter rains. Above -average spring rainfall transitioned into a **cool and dry summer**, resulting in slower ripening and allowing for full flavor development while retaining vibrant natural acidity. These conditions culminated in an exceptional vintage, with both quality and quantity exceeding expectations.



Row-selected parcels of Riesling fruit were harvested over the course of a week at their optimal ripeness. The grapes were loaded directly into the press, separating the iridescent free-run juice from gently pressed juice. After natural settling, the clarified juice was fermented at low temperatures, preserving the wine's delicate aromatics and vibrant acidity. This careful approach to winemaking ensures a fine acid line and intense fruit character.

Tasting Notes

- Color: Translucent with a pale lemon hue.
- **Nose**: Complex and rich, offering aromas of **white flowers**, **soft spice**, **lime juice**, and a hint of **chalk**, reflecting the outstanding vintage.
- Palate: A sublime and focused flavor profile, featuring notes of fresh kaffir lime, crushed granite, jasmine, and honeydew melon. These flavors weave across a delicate mineral acidity, leading to a long, evolving finish.

Did You Know?

The **Mort's Block Vineyard**, named for Mort Mitchell, represents over 50 years of family heritage. This site is part of the ancestral lands of the **Ngadjuri people**, and its carefully tended vines have consistently produced one of the Clare Valley's most celebrated Rieslings.

Wine Pairing Ideas

- **Ceviche de Poisson**: The wine's vibrant acidity complements the zesty citrus flavors of ceviche.
- Ravioli au Citron et Ricotta: The delicate aromatics enhance the creamy and tangy profile of lemon ricotta ravioli.
- **Sashimi de Saumon**: The minerality and lime-driven notes harmonize with the clean, fatty flavors of sashimi.
- **Tarte au Citron**: Its citrus-driven palate mirrors the bright flavors of a classic lemon tart.
